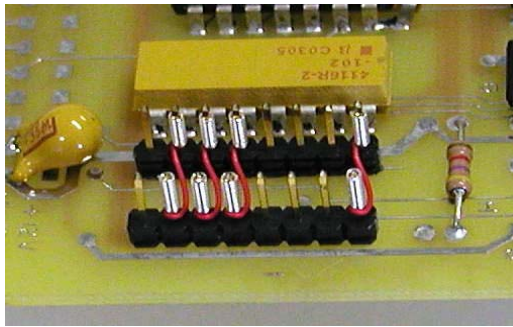

Egghead Tech Tip #2 Wire Wrapping

Some boards are used in different locations which require different addressing. On some boards, it is programmed for it's location by wire wraps. Sometimes I've seen boards that come to me defective , when the only problem is a loose wire wrap.

Wire Wraps Should Be:

- 1) A minimum of 8 turns.
- 2) Tight.
- 3) On clean post.



Wire Wraps Shouldn't Be:

- 1) Less than 8 turns.
- 2) Loose.
- 3) On corroded post.

Loose wire wraps will create an intermittent problem, which will drive you nuts.

If all of the wire wraps are correct and the board still malfunctions, Egghead Tech Services, Inc. can diagnose the problem with equipment specifically designed to simulate the exact loads.
